FUENGIROLA MARKET & MIJAS

€25

A morning visit to Fuengirola, to enjoy this popular seaside town and the famous Tuesday market, one of the largest on the coast. Lots of shops, a stroll along the promenade, or perhaps a visit to the Zoo (see below), then it's on to the delightful mountain village of Mijas, one of the most famous of the Andalucía white villages. Time to shop and explore this beautiful pueblo, with its narrow streets and wonderful views.

FUENGIROLA ZOO

€40

No cages or bars! One of the world's finest zoos, with state of the art facilities and active participation in 35 European endangered species breeding programmes. Free show daily and free guided tour of the lemur den every 30 minutes. We then visit the lovely Mijas pueblo in the afternoon.

WATER PARK

(May to October Only)

€40 (Coach & Entrance)

Get set to get wet! Cafe and bar, cloakrooms, changing rooms, showers and safety deposit boxes are available. You may also hire sun beds, etc. All you need to enjoy a really fun day out.

GRANADA

AND THE **ALHAMBRA PALACE**

€74 (€86 with lunch)

Your visit takes you inland, towards the Sierra Nevada mountains. In Granada, you have time to visit the Cathedral, explore the Moroccan shops, etc. Our coach then takes you to the amazing Alhambra palace, the most visited monument in Spain. Your official guided tour also includes the beautiful Generalife gardens.

(NB. Much walking involved. €20 deposit required.)

RONDA

BY **TRAIN & COACH**

€43 (Train ticket included)

By coach to Algeciras, then mountain train to Ronda, on a single-track line, built over 100 years ago. This spectacular mountain scenery can only be seen by train, with many villages and delightful Victorian stations on route. In Ronda you can explore the old Moorish town, including the 18th century bridge over the famous El Tajo Gorge, before rejoining the coach for the scenic journey back to the coast.

NERJA

€45 (Includes breakfast)

Our trip firstly takes us to the small town of El Palo, where we enjoy a typical Andalucía breakfast. We then follow the coast road to Spain's 3rd most visited site, the famous cave of Nerja, with the 32m high 'Cataclysmic Hall'. Inhabited for over 20,000 years, many artefacts can be seen, including prehistoric paintings in the museum. After the cave, we visit the town of Nerja, with free time to explore the sites or just amble amongst the shops and bars of this interesting town.

THE MARMALADE RUN

SPANISH LAKES & ORCHARDS

€46 (€58 with lunch)

Our trip takes us inland, to an old Olive Mill, for a fully guided tour and, when in season, where we see the full olive oil production process. (Light refreshments included.) We then visit an authentic citrus fruit farm of around 17,000 trees, where, if in season, we can sample fresh fruit, straight from the tree. A tour of the scenic Spanish Lake District follows, via the dramatic El Chorro Gorge, stopping for lunch, before then returning to the coast.

CORDOBA

€60 (€72 with lunch)

This elegant, wealthy city is one of the most beautiful in Andalucía and is home to the Mesquita, the only Mosque-Cathedral in the world, (entrance fee included). We travel through mountain scenery, olive groves and the wine-growing region. Arriving in Cordoba late morning, you will have free time to enjoy this lovely city, with its beautiful fountains, Alcazar gardens, Roman Baths and the famous Jewish Quarter.

SEVILLE

€60 (€72 with lunch)

The lovely capital city of Andalucía. Upon arrival, we take a short tour, including a visit to the majestic Plaza de Espana, La Giralda, the symbol of Seville and the Cathedral, which is one of the largest in the world (entrance fee included). You will then have free time to explore the city and perhaps take a river cruise, or ride in a horse-drawn carriage.
